The Dance:
1s lead down the middle $\mathcal{E}$ up ( $2 s \mathcal{E} 3$ step up on bars 7-8) (1s finish with $2 H$ joined in the middle of the set facing $u p$ ).
$1 \mathrm{~s}, 2 \mathrm{~s} \mathcal{E} 3$ s Promenade (on last 2 bars, 1 s cast off to 2 nd place WHILE 2s dance up to 1 st place) ( 3 s finish in 3rd place).

1s cross over to opposite sides (passing each other RS), turn 1st C RH (1st W finishes between 2s facing down, 1st man finishes between 3s facing up); 1s pass each other RS, turn 2nd C RH (1s finish in 2nd place, opp sides).

1st M wheels RH across with 2s WHILE 1st W wheels RH across with 3s; 1t W crosses up between $2 s$, casts off WHILE 1st M crosses down between 3s, casts up (1s finish in 2nd place, own sides).
